



## BACKUP FOR FLORA MARCHITA

The chords for Flora Marchita are as follows:

(A) AmEAm-E-E- (B) C-F-G-G-  
AmEAm-E-Am- G-G7-G-C-

There are, of course, many ways to play these. Here is one example of how I would play these chords on a 12/11 dulcimer. If you have a larger-range dulcimer then move the (A) part chords down one octave. *Rick Fogel*
